




Roseworthy Campus


An Education & Welfare Officer will be attending Roseworthy on Thursday 18th October between 11am-2pm in the Leske Building in room G 13.

#### **EXAMS**

Classes end for Semester 2 on October 26. Exams commence one week later.

Assignments are due and on top of this exam preparation should also be starting. Don't fall into a trap of rushing everything at the end and not doing you justice. Have a plan to pace your work so that it is all done on time.

#### Remember to:

- 1. Reference all work that is not your own in assignments.
- 2. Seek an extension if needed early.
- 3. Set up a calendar and block out exam prep sessions.
- 4. Seek support if you feel you don't have everything under control.
- 5. Check your exam timetable and make sure you go on the right day at the right time.
- 6. Go to the exam with ONLY what you are permitted to take in. DO NOT take in unauthorised materials. If in doubt ask a staff person, NOT your friend.
- 7. See an Education and Welfare Officer if you are concerned or need help with any of the above.

- A. Tax Help is an initiative of the Australian Taxation Office.


A free on-campus service is available to assist students with simple income tax returns and queries if your income was less than \$50,000 in 2011/12.

#### BE ACTIVE

It's good for your mood, improves sleep & increases your energy!

#### TAKE CARE OF YOURSELF

Pay attention to your own needs and feelings. Do things you enjoy and find relaxing and have fun!

#### CONNECT WITH OTHERS

Good relationships with family and friends are important. Accepting help and support from those who care about you can help reduce stress.

#### PRIORITISE

Set realistic goals and take small steps to deal with tasks one at a time.

#### TAKE ACTION

Make a decision to address the underlying cause of the stress.

#### KEEP THINGS IN PERSPECTIVE

Avoid blowing events out of proportion.

#### STAY POSITIVE

Find the positives in life and focus on them.

#### EAT WELL

Eating well can increase energy and influence moods.

#### **ENJOY THE SUNSHINE**

10-15 mins sun exposure per day 3-4 times per week (before 10 am & after 3 pm with no sunscreen) increases vitamin D levels. A lack of vitamin D is related to depression. Vitamin D is also necessary for melatonin productive essential for sleep!

#### IMPROVE YOUR SLEEP
