## Notes on Uma

Eri, chief of Ura

There are five kanga in Uva which are especially ~~celebrated~~<sup>known</sup>:  
Nangkonea, Nangkonea, Rankintekowae, Biribintera, Teterine and  
Terevelaba. The first three kanga are associated together  
for most purposes, as are also Teterine and Terevelaba.

Burbiwista is distinguished because it is here that the Tzotzil people landed on the coast and the Uman Antí was built. Tzutuhil is celebrated because the Uman Antí was later moved here from Burbiwista. Tetcante was well-known because the Head of the Uman Antí came from here. Tzincab and Ranchistedomai were destroyed because they were the kinsmen of the Tzotzil's descendants.

The procedure for assembling in the Uranus Arctic

The writer of *nestoria* in the *Urau Arti* is the *Konyo* of Tetsune, followed at a later stage by *Ranikintedowai*. *Burboniora* was then called, with *Ternidea* next, and ~~lastly~~ last of all *Nangkoreia*.

The work of Tectorius was to divide the field into two slabs, the first being the share of Bairditekowar and its associate neighbors, and the second the due of Tectorius, Bawbawntora and ~~Tectorius~~ Tectorius.

## The Custom of Welcoming the Stranger

The stranger is welcomed by the Karia kenza of <sup>Tenain</sup> Negusia, where his feet are washed, <sup>and</sup> he is garlanded and fed. After that he gets up and is taken to the Israels kenza at another place of the stranger in the Karieta kenza of Amaleia, ~~where the first toll~~ where he has his first toll and is greeted by Tenain. After this welcoming ~~they~~ thought is given as to where the stranger will live and be given his food.

Notes on Tabacaro

1. The Anti of the Banza of Avraheia, Umar Nakainako, Nakainako, Te I-nanoriki, associated with Marakei, were Amuria and Tabariki. Neither Amuria nor Tabariki had Rabata, but only their Bangata. Amuria was the ancestor of these banza and Tabariki their Anti. The Anti of the Banza of Karongea and Te Kanya was Bankatap.
2. We could many one's tiba torn but not one's tiba. Marriage prohibitions were enforced by the Guru.
3. The ~~other~~<sup>Head</sup> of the Te Karieta Umar Anti was Avraheia. The privilege of the Head was to be first in speaking or offering and the best slave in feasts.

The divides of food in the Umar Anti were Amuria manehu and Anteboroboro Anteboroboro. The Hatch was put on by all who had iwhi (sitting places) and each Banza entitled its own iwhi in addition.

The cutters of the canes in the Umar Anti were also Amuria and Anteboroboro, and they also had the work of putting <sup>manehu</sup> on the ridge coping. The weavers of the mats were all those Banza who had iwhi in the Umar Anti.

## The Standing of Fish at Tabewa

### The Preparation of a Table at Tabewa

If a Turtle is brought to Tabewa it is not killed ~~at once~~ at once but is ~~considered~~ considered at once : the owners who are summoned to consider when it should be killed ; and a decision is reached that it should be on such and such a day.

The Killing. Someone from the Konga of Te Ben Tiritiri comes when it is time to kill the Turtle. He gets his stick ready, and rubs it with oil and wraps it up in a mat to conceal it in his hand. When he is near to the Turtle he takes his stick and beats the Turtle until it dies.

Burning the Turtle's shell. Someone from the Konga of Teberau is called to burn it. (The killing is left unwhistled as I am unfamiliar with the process described) Ama e otaki ... ki tai come.

Cooking. This is the work of Teberau men and Temoponape; and when the Turtle is cooked the dumplings are called . Te I-Tamaihi

The Distribution. The dumplings are the Konga of Aor te Boabobo. There were two shares : Te Karieta and its Konga, and Te Karia and its Konga. Te Karieta got the head and half the side ; and to Te Karia the back and half the side . After that came the ~~first~~ eating .
