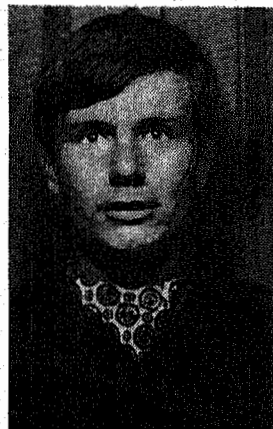


GENERAL NOMINATION

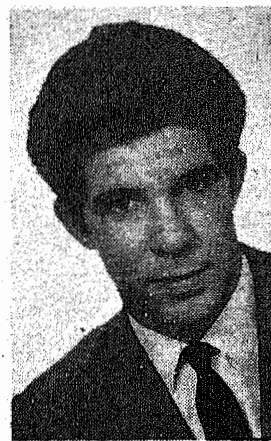
Politics - Left-wing, but rather non-committal. Some sympathy with S.D.A. ideals but not their actions.
