DIALECT

OF THE

LAKE AMADEUS AND GEORGE GILL RANGE ABORIGINALS.

The vocabulary of words attached to this introduction is that spoken by the natives who inhabit the George Gill Ranges, Lake Amadeus, Tempe Downs, Erldunda, and a large portion of the western territory of central Australia.

The reader will quite understand that before I could submit such a number of words to paper I had to learn them and their meaning, which has cost me endless trouble, and also an indirect expense. A man who would go to the trouble to learn the Alice Springs language, as I did, and then be told that henceforward his duties would all be to the far west, would, if he wished to keep time with the natives of a new soil to him, have to learn their dialect also. Well, this I did, and in the short time I have been in the west I consider I have made very fair advancement. Anyhow, I know enough to show the difference between the two dialects, viz., that of the Alice Springs blacks and that of the Lake Amadeus blacks.

I am not writing to profit by it in a pecuniary sense. I do this for the good of my country—South Australia—and for the benefit of the Geographical Society and Australian Natives' Association, two admirable institutions. Of the latter, I have the honor to be a member, which I feel proud of; of the former, with all my years' plodding across unknown portions of the vast central Australia, I have not come under their notice yet. Perhaps this is because I have no influence in that direction. No doubt some who read this humble production will be aware that some two years ago I had published a little pamphlet entitled "The Aborigines of Central Australia," with a vocabulary of the Alice Springs native dialect included, which I have again included in this little work.

"At-wa," pronounced hatwor, is a full grown blackfellow on whom the ceremony of circumcision has been performed.

"Ap-murika," pronounced hap-murry-ka, is a boy on whom the ceremony has not been performed.

"Ar-rilta" is what the penis is called after the rite. They first cut the foreskin off, and about a fortnight after they cut the pipe or urethra underneath about an inch down, beginning at the head of penis. This is done right through the from Strangways continent, Springs to Daly Waters, and north of the Daly it ceases.

"Ara-gudge-ha" is a full grown woman and owned by a blackfellow, and mostly with some

offspring.

"Ara-goodge-a-wonga" is a young girl about sixteen or seventeen, with breasts showing, and eligible to become the wife of some young

blackfellow.
"Ap-po-nunga." There are four classes, which are divided as fol-

lows: — "Apponunga," "Perula,"
"Pultarra," and "Comarra."
"Etra-ketra" is the native word for whore. They are all unfaithful and addicted to sexual pleasures, and practice unlawful commerce with anybody.

"Ee-ningee-lab-lab" is a pretty little bird that we in English call

"Robin redbreast."

"Yerra-col-ya" is used for carrying water or little bahies in; it is a piece of the bean tree scooped out. When it is full of water, and being carried by lubras, they put grass on top of the water to keep it from spilling.

"Ad-na-mira" means running water.

"Ara-coola" means you go in front. For instance, "Hung-ar-a-lidgea-guy-ara-coola" means you take the lead, or you walk in front.

"Uni-ba-coora," a little child of either sex. For instance, let us say "Umba-coora Pichi," which means

come here my boy.

"Oorootima" is the name of the hill that the blackfellows call a burning mountain; they tell the lubras that the stones are all on fire inside. I was twelve days trying to get a lubra to show me the hill, and when I did get there with her she would not go close; so I went myself and saw nothing. It is not the first time that I have been fooled by the superstitions of old niggers. There is not the slightest doubt but what the aboriginals know something about burning mountains. They have explained it all to me, just as a burning mountain is. They have on their own accord mentioned the crater and the upheaving, also streams of running lava. The next nigger that speaks of a volcano to me will be marched alongside of the camels with a neck chain on, right to the spot, and if there is no volcano that nigger is in for some hot coffee.

"Um-born-ditch-a-licka." An imaginary lubra who lives in all ranges, in fact it is a supersti-tion. "Um-born-ditch-a-ticka" cures all natives that are ill or suffering from some complaint. It is some dry, red, soft stone, powdered up and put on sores. Young men who have just been circumcised go to some range and remain there for a week or so, and lubras believe that "Um-born-

ditch-a-licka" makes them well. "Mon-Minn" is a bush that when the leaves are dry and put into a small hole of water make a kind of tea; it is done for the purpose of catching emus. All other holes of water are covered up with boughs, and when emus drink this they become giddy and drunk; then the blacks catch them whilst in this state. bush is not very plentiful, therefore the natives generally carry some with them all ready for use.
