My dear Frank,

I am returning your suggested draft with no modification save on the first page a reference to University degrees, where shared responsibility in joint publications is often a matter of great difficulty.

I suppose any instruction to contributors by editors must be exceedingly brief and might be no more than ~~in~~ ⁱⁿ cases of joint authorship, authors should, so far as is possible, specify their ^{respective} individual contributions if individual credit is to be reserved in ^{regard to} ~~respect of~~ the conferment of University ~~Doctorates~~ degrees, etc. Acknowledgements also should be, so far as possible, specific."
