Dear Mrs Tysser,

Subject to the approval of the College, I propose to go ahead with the appointment of which I wrote, and for this purpose I have drawn up the following terms, which I hope will be acceptable to the College, though I have not yet heard from them.

- 1) Initial salary £3 a week, rising by biennial increments to a maximum of £4 a week.
- 2) The appointment is for the duration of the war, and is intended to terminate at the end of the year in which war ceases.
- 3) The duties will be to carry out computations under my immediate supervision.

I hope also they may seem sufficiently attractive for you to let me know, after considering them, that you would like to be appointed.
