What I said about Geyer's

may vary in blackness, $\frac{1}{2}$ more
black and $\frac{1}{2}$ lighter, and selection
can pick freely between them as
blackness is not tied to any other
quality as regards utility. The

Selection is the same whether it
the quality depends on one factor.
But that is another matter. The
change in features due to a
change in ductless glands may
be regarded as one quality in
this sense, and it is natural
that such differences should exist
between races, I think.
