My dear Fisher,

Here is a copy of a note I am considering whether to put at the end of my paper. No one will understand it, except perhaps you!

But it is a curious point, on which I have consulted a psychologist with not success.

You will get a proof of my paper before long, without which this will be hardly intelligible. On another

point, I don't see why you
consider yourself responsible about
the Mond row. Mudge is an
impulsive hot-headed man, &
he would try to turn us into an
anti-semitic Society. This, to me,
would be most objectionable,
though I don't love that race.
A general effort to check all
immigration would have my
sympathy. It seems to me a
more practicable line to go
than an attack on a race.

A poverty and physical test
could be made to keep out
95% of those who want to
come from the ~~protest~~ Poland
for example.
