Dear Fisher,

I met Raymond Pearl the other day and had a long Eugenic talk with him. I mentioned your paper and he was anxious to see it. Could you send him a copy? In my paper I was thinking mainly of the limitations of families with reference to altered economic conditions and not to the effect of State Subsidies to parenthood. I had better make this more clear. Law 2 on page 6 should, I think, read "the size of the family should be limited with reference to wages or salary earned or to be earned".
