Thanks for your letter. I hope to have a chance to see your film some time. I have been wanting to get you to come down and see my poultry experiment; this year is the critical year, in which I am trying to make out homozygotes and a lot of interesting stuff is coming out. In fact I feel sure that in at least five cases out of the seven tested, the homozygotes are recognisable without the slightest difficulty. As however this is the first year I have seen them, they must be tested next year with back-crosses, but I have been having surprises nearly every fortnight, and I should like you to see the stuff while it is young.

I believe Crew means to come down on Tuesday 26th., and mention this on the chance that the same day might suit you.
